Parking Reminders:



All students parking on campus must display a PVHS parking permit from the center mirror in their vehicle. If a student still needs

a parking permit, they must fill out the **Student Parking Application** and submit a \$20 donation to the Student Store.

Students are not permitted to park in any spot behind the Main Office before or during school hours, Monday - Friday. Spots reserved for staff in the Main Lot are marked with a yellow stripe and are numbered.

Off Campus Pass Information

All students are required to stay on campus during school hours, including the Nutrition Break and Lunch Break. Even if a student has no class on their schedule during 3rd or 6th period, a student must stay on campus during lunch as the school is responsible for a student until their free period starts.

With an **Off Campus Pass**, students are allowed to leave campus at the start of lunch on days they do not have a class after lunch.

- An **A-Day Off Campus Pass** allows a student to leave school at lunch on A Days if they do not have a 3rd period class on their schedule.
- A **B-Day Off Campus Pass** allows a student to leave school at lunch on B Days if they do not have a 6th period class on their schedule.

The procedure for a student getting an off-campus pass is as follows:

- 1) Student requests an Off-Campus pass from the Attendance Office.
- 2) The Attendance Office emails the *Off Campus Pass Request Parent Letter* home to a parent of a student.
- 3) The parent fills out a consent form agreeing to allow their student off campus at lunch time.
- 4) A student comes in to get their Off Campus Pass Sticker from the Attendance Office.

Please note: Once a student leaves campus for the day, they are no longer under the supervision or PVHS staff and are under the care and responsibility of their parent or guardian.

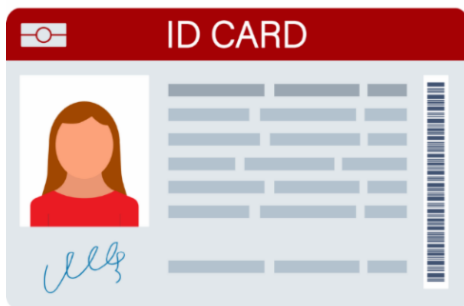

Dear County and District Superintendents, Charter School Administrators, High School Principals, Counselors, and Scholarship Coordinators:

2024 United States Senate Youth Program

I am pleased to announce the 2024 United States Senate Youth Program (USSYP). All public and private high schools in the state are invited to nominate up to two outstanding juniors or seniors who are interested in pursuing careers in public service to participate in this educational program coordinated by the California Department of Education (CDE).

Two student delegates from each state will be selected to attend this unique educational experience. The 62nd Annual Washington Week is to be held in person, for the first time since the pandemic, in Washington, D.C., March 2–9, 2024. Student delegates will partake in a comprehensive, interactive leadership program, and each will receive a \$10,000 college scholarship.

To apply, students must be nominated by their high school principal and currently serve in an elected or appointed leadership capacity in a student government, civic, or educational organization for the entire 2023–24 school year. In addition, nominated students must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents, be currently enrolled in a California public or private secondary school, and live in California for the entire academic year. Four finalists, consisting of two delegates and a first and second alternate, will be selected by the CDE to be California's USSYP representatives.

The application and scholarship information for the 2024 USSYP are available on the CDE USSYP web page at <https://www.cde.ca.gov/eo/in/us/>. The deadline to apply is Monday, October 9, 2023.

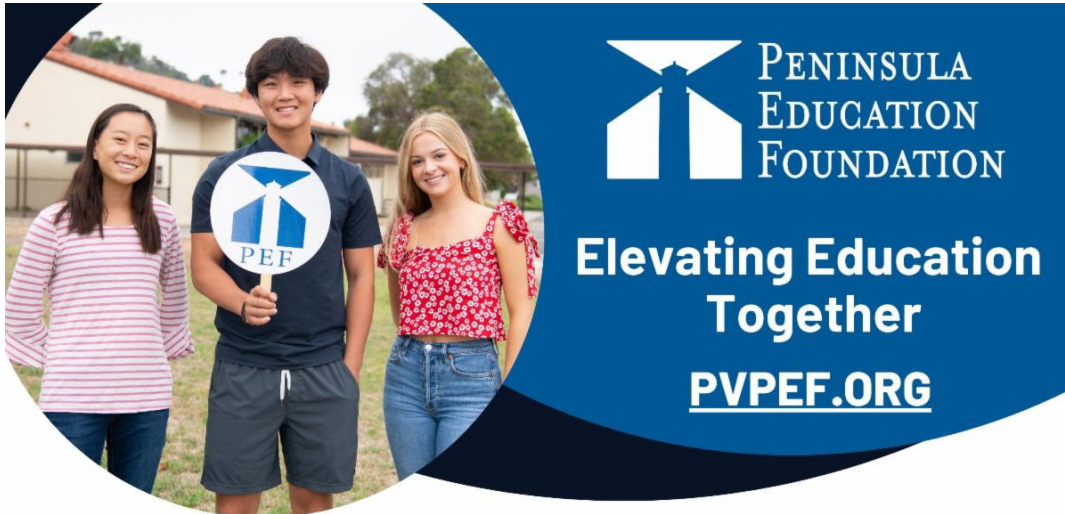
