

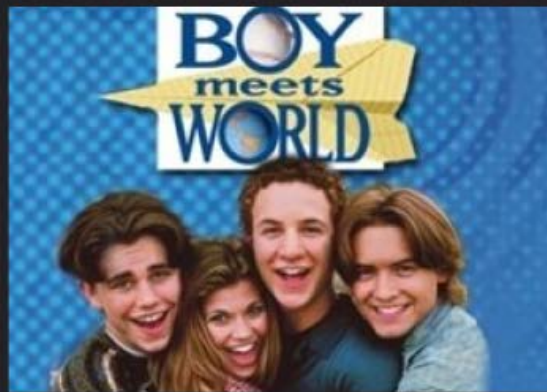

The Palos Verdes High School College Career Center has partnered with Compass Education to offer at-home, computer-proctored [Digital Adaptive SAT](#) and [ACT](#) practice tests at no cost through [Compass' Online Testing Center](#). While the [Digital Adaptive SAT](#) will give students the opportunity to experience the new format of the test, the computer-proctored ACT practice test matches the current paper/pencil, linear version of the test.

These practice tests provide our students with just that... practice before taking a college entrance exam!

Many sophomores and juniors will attempt both tests in order to be thorough in their planning. We recommend prioritizing the Digital Adaptive SAT (the least familiar to students), then the linear ACT (a popular choice due to perceived stability in this transition year to a new SAT).

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**SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES and DEADLINES:**

**JANUARY 23 - EDISON SCHOLARS (\$50,000)** - for seniors who want to make a difference in the world by studying science, technology, engineering or math (STEM) in college. Requirements for applying include having at least a GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale and show financial need.

**FEBRUARY 5 - ELK'S LEGACY AWARD (\$4,000)** – seniors only; any child/grandchild of a living Elk who joined the order on or before April 1, 2020, is eligible to apply. Candidates who qualify are judged on knowledge, charity, community service, and integrity.

**FEBRUARY 28 – LOS ANGELES MILITARY CHARITABLE FUND SCHOLARSHIP (Varies)** – seniors only; must be a child of an active, retired service member or current or retired Dept. of Defense employee; awarded on academic performance, extracurricular activities, demonstrated leadership, and applicant's character.

**FEBRUARY 29 – MARY P. WYATT SCHOLARSHIP (\$865)** – PVHS seniors only; min 3.0 GPA; demonstrates financial need; actively helps others.

**MARCH 1 – SONS OF ITALY SCHOLARSHIP (\$500 - \$5,000)** – seniors only; must be wholly or partially of Italian Descent; selection based on scholastic record, activities evidencing leadership, financial need, written personal goals statement, essay of Italian Origin, and letters of recommendation.

**MARCH 7 – PERRAULT FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP (\$930)** - awarded to a senior, male or female, who has been a member of the PVHS Varsity Soccer Team during their senior year. Criteria includes leadership, commitment to the sport and academic achievement. Preference given to soccer players who have played defensive positions.

**MARCH 20 – PV PENINSULA LIONS CLUB (\$500 - \$1,000)** - seniors only; consideration will be given to academic achievement (min. GPA of 3.0), service to others, leadership, financial need and a strong desire/plan for further education/professional focus.

**MARCH 22 – SUSAN PAVELKA SCHOLARSHIP FOR JOURNALISTIC EXCELLENCE (\$500)** - for a college-bound senior who has participated and excelled in PVHS journalism. Candidates are eligible to apply after fulfilling a minimum of two consecutive years as a leader/writer in one or more of these journalism programs: yearbook, literary magazine, newspaper, podcast or broadcast news.

## **APRIL 1 – SOUTH BAY JAPANESE AMERICAN CITIZEN LEAGUE**

(Varies) – Scholarships are open to all high school seniors of Japanese American ancestry residing in the South Bay JACL Chapter area and a member of the JACL. Students are required to fill out only one application for the scholarships listed below. The committee will select the recipients for each of the scholarships based upon the requirements:

- Kiichi Egashira Memorial Scholarship - for students pursuing a bachelor's degree in physical and biological sciences, engineering/mathematics.
- Janice Kobata Zoeger Memorial Scholarship - for students in pursuit of a bachelor's in any field of study relating to biological sciences, foreign and/or ancient language or business.
- Ernest K. Tsujimoto Memorial Scholarship - for students in pursuit of an undergraduate degree majoring in the STEM fields.

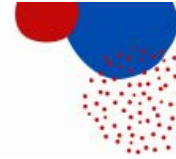
