

We will be holding baseball tryouts for our program on Tuesday,
November 5, through Friday, November 8, holding Saturday, November
9, in case of any issues (weather-related or otherwise). Tryouts will
be after school out on the baseball field.

We have allowed a slot of 3:30pm to 5:30pm but do not plan to use the full two-hours every day.

If you are not able to attend the tryouts because of travel and/or injury, please contact me in advance to let me know you won't be able to tryout. My classroom is Room 309.

If you are a fall athlete and competing on the varsity level after November 5th, do not tryout for baseball until the current fall season officially concludes.

If you're a winter athlete, you have two choices:

- 1) Arrange with your winter sport coach to try out for baseball
- 2) Tryout at the end of the winter sport season, in early February.

Reminders:

Dress to play the game of baseball—hat, pants, with all equipment, including a glove, bat, and position-specific equipment.

Expect to throw, hit, run, and pitch (if you're a pitcher).

Those who make the team should expect to have practices and games over / Spring Break.


