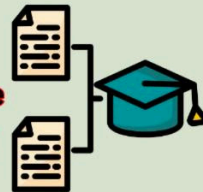

Counseling Office Announcements and Important Dates:

Class of 2025 Senior Packet Deadlines:

- **All Other Application deadlines** must submit their Senior Packets to their counselor's box by **Friday, November 1, 2024.**
 - This is important for students who are requesting a counselor letter of recommendation to ensure their counselor can write a letter of recommendation on time.
- Seniors who are not applying to a two-year or four-year college and have other plans after high school, please complete the **Future Plans Document** enclosed in your Senior Packet and submit this along with a resume to your counselor's box.

November 1: Last day to drop a class with a "W". November 1 will be the last day to withdraw from a class with a "W" for withdrawal on your transcript. It is recommended that students speak with their teacher to discuss any questions or concerns about their performance class, as well as seek the support of their counselor for improvement strategies. Please see your counselor if you wish to discuss a withdrawal and understand more about this. If a withdraw occurs after the November 1 deadline, an "F" will be recorded on the transcript regardless of the academic grade.

Thank you for your interest in Palos Verdes Baseball

We will be holding baseball tryouts for our program on Tuesday, November 5, through Friday, November 8, holding Saturday, November 9, in case of any issues (weather-related or otherwise). Tryouts will be after school out on the baseball field.

We have allowed a slot of 3:30pm to 5:30pm but do not plan to use the full two-hours every day.
