Trust no one when CLUE comes to the PV High Stage

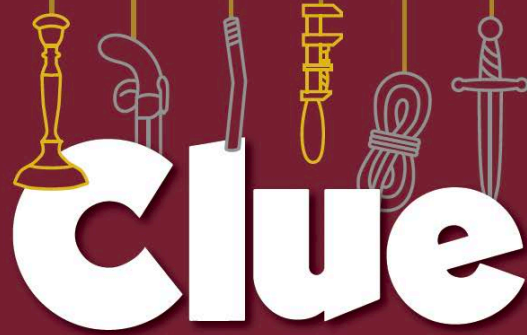

Mr. Hill and Mrs. Shulman reviewed the can't miss events of the month, including:

**There are 7 weeks left in the semester!**

**November 12-15** - Final Interims come out for students with a D or F in a class, or C in an honors or AP class.

**Need support in a class in the last 8 weeks of the Semester?**

Consider Math Lab, Core Skills Training, or come to the counseling office for a copy of the peer tutor list!

**Math Lab** (Free Peer Math Tutoring during lunch)

**Who can attend?** Any student can attend Math Lab! Math Lab provides drop-in tutoring, and students can bring homework, study guides, or any other materials they want to work with a tutor one-on-one. Once a student comes in the door, one of the staff gets them partnered with an appropriate tutor.

**Who are the tutors?** Math Lab Tutors apply and are selected from high level math classes, including AP Calculus BC, AP Calculus BC, AP Statistics, and PreCalculus Honors. Once selected, each tutor must attend at least 70% of Math Labs sessions at lunch. If they do, they are able to add "Peer Tutor" to their transcript.

**Other benefits are there from Math Lab?** This year, our amazing PVHS math department teachers have come together to help grow and expand Math Lab. All non-honors/AP math teachers, are offering one 1 extra credit point for every Math Lab attended. These classes are listed below:

- Algebra 1
- Geometry
- Algebra 2
- Pre Calc
- Pre Calc with Limits
- Statistics

**Core Skills Training (CST)** - After-school small group instruction on core concepts of the subject by a PVHS teacher.

Algebra 1 Training Sessions are on: Monday and Wednesday

Geometry Training Sessions are on: Tuesdays and Thursdays

Algebra 2 Training Sessions are on: Wednesdays

English 1 Training Sessions are on Tuesdays and Wednesdays

**Thank you for your interest in Palos Verdes Baseball**

**We will be holding baseball tryouts for our program on Tuesday, November 5, through Friday, November 8, holding Saturday, November 9, in case of any issues (weather-related or otherwise). Tryouts will be after school out on the baseball field.**
