SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES and DEADLINES:

<u>DECEMBER 31 - AYSO JEFF RICKEL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$2,000)</u> - awarded to a college-bound senior who has played soccer in, and given volunteer service to the American Youth Soccer Organization (AYSO), Region 10. Applicant must demonstrate an understanding of the importance of good sportsmanship.

<u>JANUARY 3 - GE REAGAN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP (up to \$40,000)</u> – for seniors only who demonstrate at school, at the workplace, and within the community the attributes of leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship; demonstrate strong academic performance; be citizens of the United States.

<u>JANUARY 23 - EDISON SCHOLARS (\$50,000)</u> - for seniors who want to make a difference in the world by studying science, technology, engineering or math (STEM) in college. Requirements for applying include having at least a GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale and show financial need ·

<u>FEBRUARY 5 - ELK'S LEGACY AWARD (\$4,000)</u> – seniors only; any child/grandchild of a living Elk who joined the order on or before April 1, 2022 is eligible to apply. Candidates who qualify are judged on knowledge, charity, community service, and integrity.
