Counseling Office Announcements and Important Dates:

Last Day to Make a Schedule Change - Friday August 30: If you still have questions or concerns about a class on your schedule, please come speak with your counselor about this. We are here to help! Keep in mind, **Friday, August 30 is the last day to make a schedule change.** This type of change means adding a new class to your schedule, changing a class for something else, or dropping a class. Please note all schedule changes are based on space availability and counselors will make every effort to help you.

Last Day to Drop/Level Down - Friday, October 4: This date is the last day to drop a class or level down from an AP or Honors class to a college prep (regular level) class without the course appearing on your transcript. Please be sure to speak with your counselor prior to October 4 if you are considering a change to your schedule. Keep in mind that a schedule change is based on space

availability and the ability to work in your schedule. Any schedule changes after October 4 will result in a 'W' for Withdrawal from the class and must occur by November 1.

Senior Conferences: Class of 2025 - Your Senior Conferences will take place on Tuesday, September 3 and Wednesday, September 4 during English class. You will have the opportunity to meet with your counselor to receive important information about post-secondary options, the college application process, letter of recommendation process, and receive your Senior Packet and transcript. Your counselors can't wait to start working with you through this exciting time!

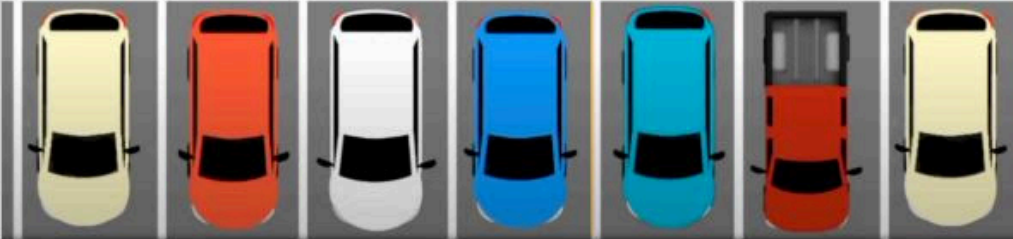

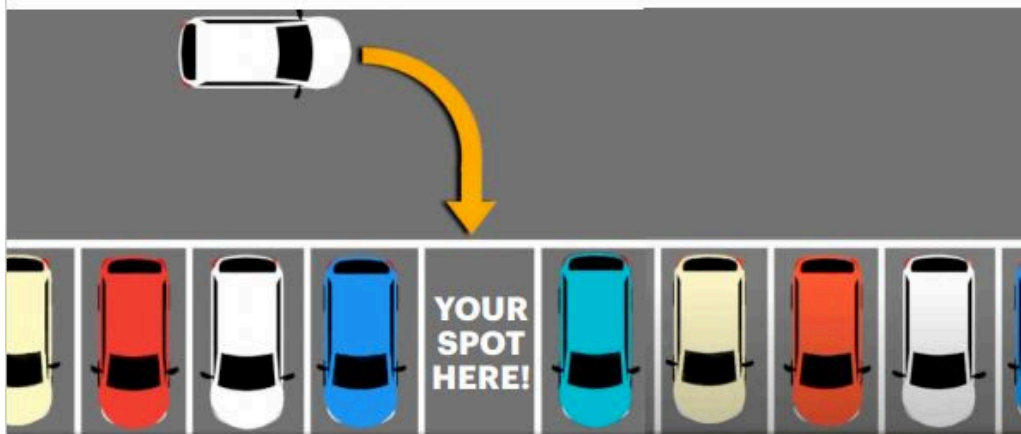
