PVPLC High School Naturalist Internship Program Accepting Applications for Fall & Winter 2024 - This program is offered by the Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy (PVPLC). Through this program, interns volunteer in both George F Canyon Nature Center and White Point Nature Education Center as well as in the adjacent Nature Preserves. Interns shadow PVPLC Nature Center Staff to assist with greeting visitors, facilitating programs, community science projects, trail monitoring, animal care and facility maintenance. Interns also receive a checklist of enrichment requirements including reading and activities that they complete to round out their knowledge during their internship. This is an unpaid internship and interns must be age 16 or above when they start. Interns are required to complete 25 hours of shifts and enrichments to complete this program. Counseling Office Announcements and Important Dates:

Student Tutoring Applications: The counseling office is in search for dedicated tutors for the Student Tutoring List. Please locate applications in the Counseling Office at the front counter. Students who apply to be a student tutor should be high achieving junior and senior students with interest in tutoring their peers as well as elementary and middle school students. Sophomore students who are enrolled in AP and honors classes are encouraged to apply as well. Applications are due to Ms. Gill's box by the end of the day, Friday, September 27.

Class of 2025 Senior Packet Deadlines:

- Seniors with **Early Action/Early Decision Application deadlines** must submit their Senior Packets to their counselor's box by **Monday, September 23, 2024.**
- Seniors with **All Other Application deadlines** must submit their Senior Packets to their counselor's box by **Friday, November 1, 2024.**
 - This is important for students who are requesting a counselor letter of recommendation to ensure their counselor can write a letter of recommendation on time.
- Seniors who are not applying to a two-year or four-year college and have other plans after high school, please complete the **Future Plans Document** enclosed in your Senior Packet and submit this along with a resume to your counselor's box.

Last Day to Drop/Level Down - Friday, October 4: This date is the last day to drop a class or level down from an AP or Honors class to a college prep (regular level) class without the course appearing on your transcript. Please be sure to speak with your counselor prior to October 4 if you are considering a change to your schedule. Keep in mind that a schedule change is based on space availability and the ability to work in your schedule. Any schedule changes after October 4 will result in a **'W'** for Withdrawal from the class and must occur by November 1.

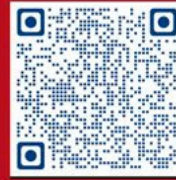

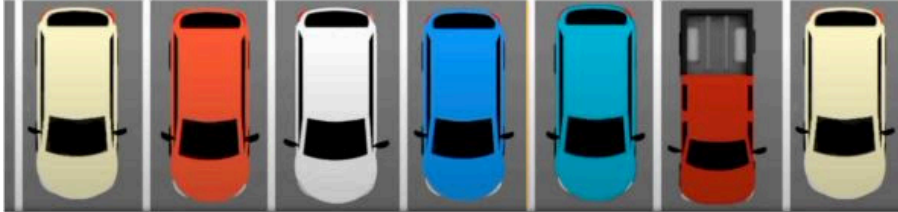
