Counseling Office Announcements and Important Dates:

Class of 2026 Junior Parents: The Junior Parent Presentation Part 1) will be held on Wednesday, October 16, 2024. Please join the counselors for introductory information on to post-secondary planning, college admissions testing, and more. Part 2 of the Junior Parent Presentation series will be held in

the spring semester. We look forward to seeing you at 9am via Webinar (**advanced registration required [here](#)**) or at 6pm in the PVHS MPR. The same information will be covered at both presentations, so you only need to attend one.

Class of 2025 Senior Packet Deadlines:

- Seniors with **Early Action/Early Decision Application deadlines** must submit their Senior Packets to their counselor's box by **Monday, September 23, 2024**.
- Seniors with **All Other Application deadlines** must submit their Senior Packets to their counselor's box by **Friday, November 1, 2024**.
 - This is important for students who are requesting a counselor letter of recommendation to ensure their counselor can write a letter of recommendation on time.
- Seniors who are not applying to a two-year or four-year college and have other plans after high school, please complete the **Future Plans Document** enclosed in your Senior Packet and submit this along with a resume to your counselor's box.

Last Day to Drop/Level Down - Friday, October 4: This date is the last day to drop a class or level down from an AP or Honors class to a college prep (regular level) class without the course appearing on your transcript. Please be sure to speak with your counselor prior to October 4 if you are considering a change to your schedule. Keep in mind that a schedule change is based on space availability and the ability to work in your schedule. Any schedule changes after October 4 will result in a **'W'** for Withdrawal from the class and must occur by November 1.

COLLEGE TEST DAY (PSAT/NMSQT)! JUNIOR CLASS OF 2026

Wednesday, October 23rd is a MODIFIED "A-DAY" schedule.

**Junior Students REPORT TO CAMPUS NO LATER THAN 8:15AM
No Late Seating!**

Class of 2026: Juniors will take the PSAT/NMSQT on College Test Day, Oct. 23, 2024. This exam prepares students who might plan on taking the SAT and can qualify our Juniors for the prestigious [National Merit Scholarship](#) program.

There is no need to register for the PSAT/NMSQT with PVHS or the CollegeBoard (This is free to PVHS Juniors). **ALL CURRENT JUNIORS HAVE BEEN REGISTERED**; students are **not REQUIRED** to take this practice exam and **may opt out** if they wish. Parent/Guardian wishing to opt their student out of the PSAT/NMSQT should **email Assoc. Principal Dr. Kyle Garrity** confirming their student will not test, but will attend the **Adjusted A Day** beginning 11:30am. Room assignments will be posted on campus during test week or sooner. To prepare for this exam, students may read through the [PSAT/NMSQT Student Guide](#) and take the Practice Test(s) online.

All students opting to test are required to report to campus and check in at their assigned classroom **no later than 8:15am on October 23rd. There will be NO TIME to spare on October 23;** the PSAT/NMSQT testing begins promptly @ 8:30am SHARP! There is **NO LATE SEATING** for this exam.

Students must arrive on campus by 8:15am with [approved calculators](#) and go directly to their assigned room. Please check the approved calculator list before testing! Students are allowed to use a calculator on all questions in the Math section. **The digital test platform itself has a built-in graphing calculator** that students may use, if they wish, or a student can use their own approved calculator.

Cell phones will be powered off/silenced 8:30am – 11:30am and accessed only once testing is over.

Schedule for JUNIOR CLASS on OCTOBER 23rd to follow later in October.

OUTSIDE OPPORTUNITIES:

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES and DEADLINES:

- **SEPTEMBER 30 - COCA COLA SCHOLARS (\$20,000)** – this is an achievement-based scholarship awarded to graduating high school seniors. Students are recognized for their capacity to lead and serve, as well as their commitment to making a significant impact on their schools and communities.
