



**PVPLC High School Naturalist Internship Program Accepting Applications for Fall & Winter 2024** - This program is offered by the Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy (PVPLC). Through this program, interns volunteer in both George F Canyon Nature Center and White Point Nature Education Center as well as in the adjacent Nature Preserves. Interns shadow PVPLC Nature Center Staff to assist with greeting visitors, facilitating programs, community science projects, trail monitoring, animal care and facility maintenance. Interns also receive a checklist of enrichment requirements including reading and activities that they complete to round out their knowledge during their internship. This is an unpaid internship and interns must be age 16 or above when they start. Interns are required to complete 25 hours of shifts and enrichments to complete this program. **Counseling Office Announcements and Important Dates:** 

Last Day to Drop/Level Down - Friday, October 4: This date is the last day to drop a class or level down from an AP or Honors class to a college prep (regular level) class without the course appearing on your transcript. Please be sure to speak with your counselor prior to October 4 if you are considering a change to your schedule. Keep in mind that a schedule change is based on space availability and the ability to work in your schedule. Any schedule changes after October 4 will result in a 'W' for Withdrawal from the class and must occur by November 1.

#### OUTSIDE OPPORTUNITES

**STUDENT ELECTION WORKER PROGRAM** coordinated by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk would like to encourage students of 16 years of age or older to **volunteer as a student election worker** for the upcoming **November 5 Presidential General Election**. All students placed must attend two training sessions (one in-person and one online session) before their assignment. All students who are placed will be given the following 3-day assignment:

- Saturday, November 2: 9 am 8 pm
- Sunday, November 3: 9 am 8 pm
- Tuesday, November 5: 6 am 9 pm

Students are assigned to a precinct near their home or school. Participating students earn a stipend up to \$380 along with hands on experience with the democratic process. Any high school student that meets the following requirements may apply:

- Must be a U.S. Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident AND 16 years of age
- Must be attending a public/private secondary institution
- Must be in good academic standing with a GPA of 2.5 or greater
- Must have teacher AND parental consent


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


