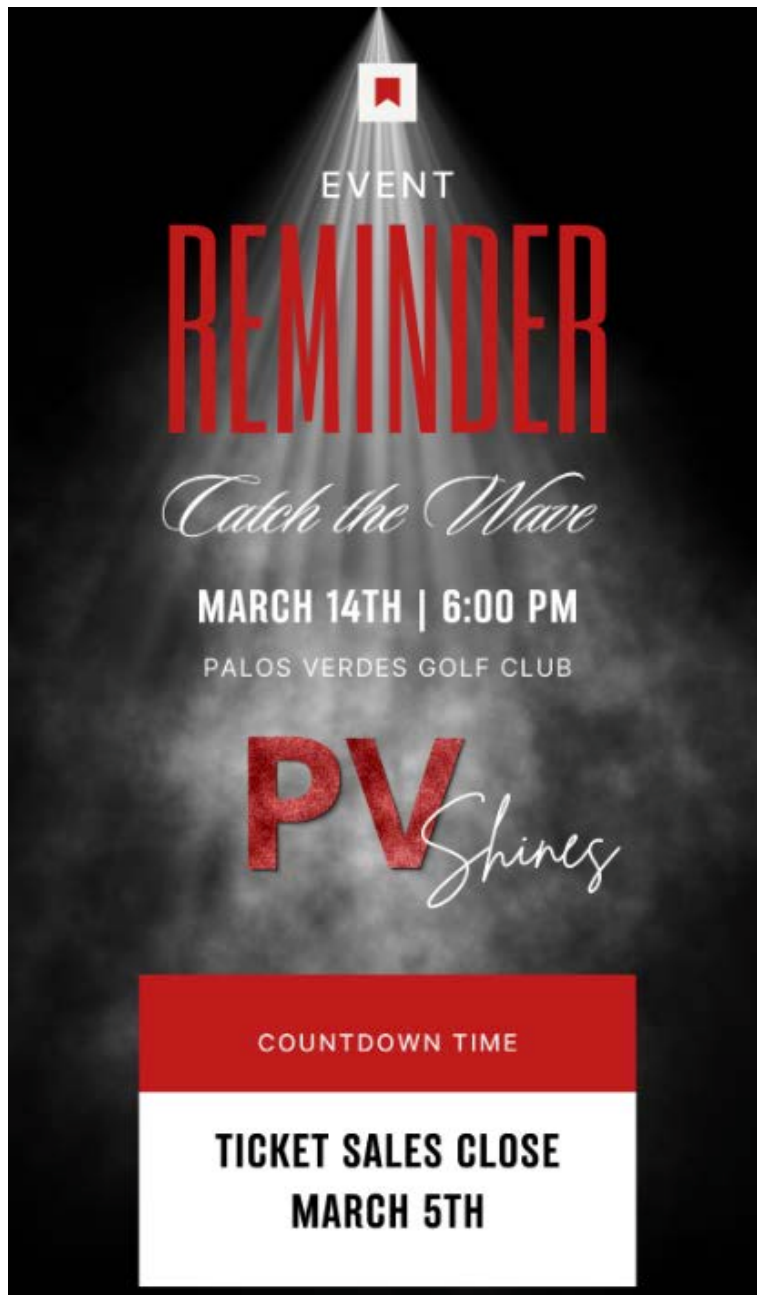

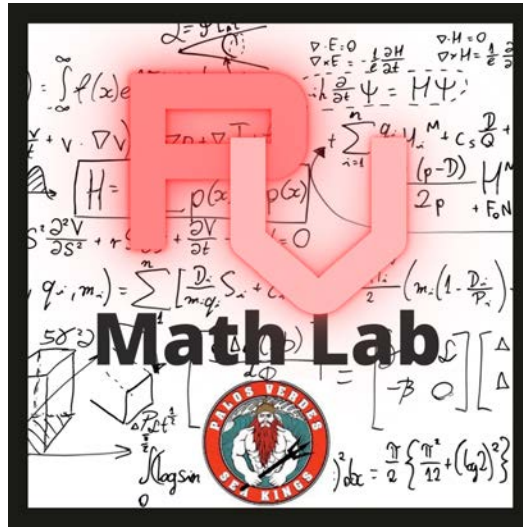
COUNSELING

Incoming Freshmen Parent Night: The Incoming Freshmen Parent Night will be held on **Wednesday, March 12 at 6pm in the PVHS MPR**. This evening is for new PVHS Parents/Guardians only (no students). We look forward to orienting our new Sea King Parents with all that PVHS has to offer. After the first hour in the MPR, the second hour will be spent in breakout sessions with your student's future high school counselor. For more information, please look for a flier mailed home this week. A constant contact will be following with a special Counseling Can't Miss video special just for our new Sea King families!

Junior Class of 2026: The **Junior Parent Presentation Part 2** will take place on **Wednesday, April 2**. We invite all parents and guardians for an overview of summer preparation and plans for their rising senior students, the college application platforms, essay writing, teacher and counselor letter of recommendation process, and more. We will also share opportunities for students who have plans that do not include four-year college. The summer before senior year is an important time for organization and preparation.

All Students: The last day to **Withdraw** from a class is **Friday, March 14**. A Withdrawal will issue a **W on the student's transcript**. Counselors are available to meet with students for any questions or concerns about their grades.



Math Lab is Free Peer Math Tutoring during lunch in room 407.

Who can attend? Any student can attend Math Lab! Math Lab provides drop-in tutoring, and students can bring homework, study guides, or any other materials they want to work with a tutor one-on-one. Once a student comes in the door, one of the staff gets them partnered with an appropriate tutor.

Who are the tutors? Math Lab Tutors apply and are selected from high level math classes, including AP Calculus BC, AP Calculus AB, AP Statistics, and PreCalculus Honors. Once selected, each tutor must attend at least 70% of Math Labs sessions at lunch. If they do, they are able to add "Peer Tutor" to their transcript.

Other benefits are there from Math Lab? All non-honors/AP math teachers, are offering one 1 extra credit point for every Math Lab attended. These classes are listed below:

- Algebra 1
- Geometry
- Algebra 2
- Pre Calc
- Pre Calc with Limits
- Statistics

Introducing... Spanish Lab!

This semester, PVHS is proud to offer more support for our students in Spanish! Based on the same model as Math Lab, students can receive free drop-in tutoring at lunch!

How does it work? Any student can attend Spanish Lab! Students looking to be tutored in Spanish can bring homework, study guides, or any other materials they want to work with a tutor one-on-one. Once a student comes in the door, one of the staff gets them partnered with an appropriate tutor.

Who are the tutors? Spanish Lab Tutors apply and are selected from high level Spanish classes, including Spanish AP Language, Spanish AP Literature, Spanish 4 and Spanish 5. Once selected, each tutor must attend at least 70% of

Spanish Labs sessions at lunch. If they do, they are able to add "Peer Tutor" to their transcript.

Other benefits are there from Spanish Lab? All Spanish 1 and Spanish 2 teachers, are offering one 1 extra credit point for every Spanish Lab attended.

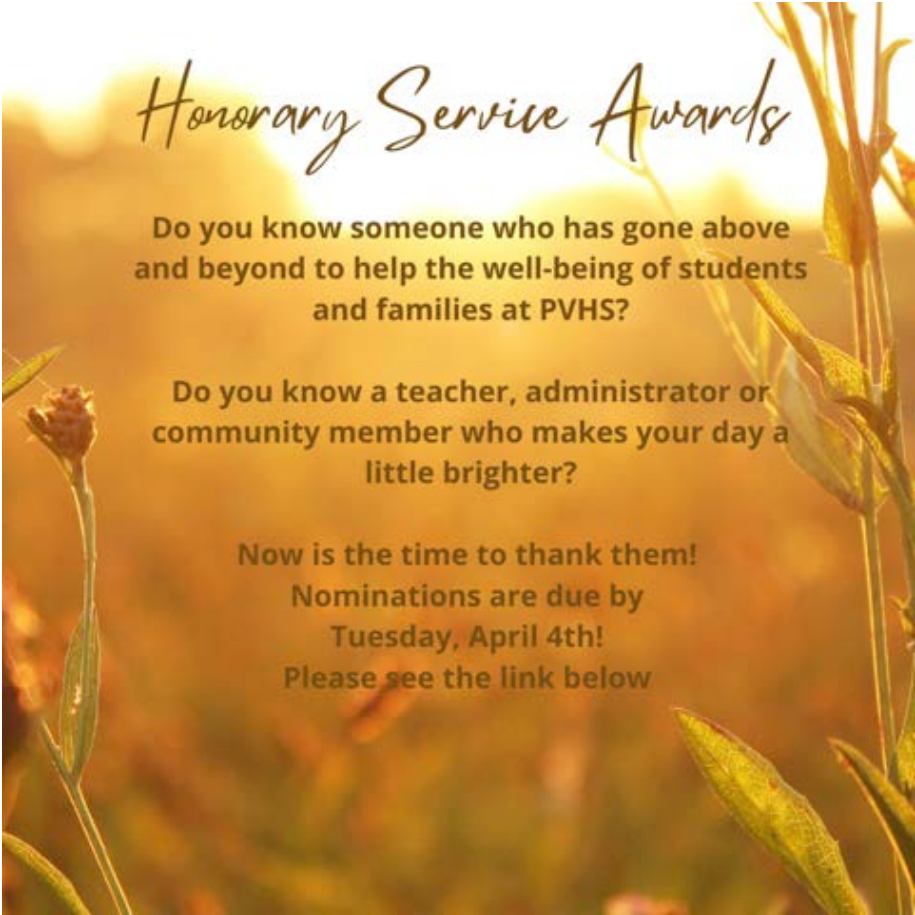
