Some info about Link Crew:

Leader trainings and Orientation are **mandatory** and will be held on August 13th and 14th OR August 15th and 16th. Orientation is Tuesday, August 18th. More information available on the application.

Link Crew is a high school transition program that welcomes freshmen and makes them feel comfortable throughout the first year of their high school experience. Built on the belief that students can help students succeed, Link Crew trains members of the junior and senior classes to be Link Leaders. As positive role models, Link Leaders are motivators, leaders, and teachers who guide the freshmen to discover what it takes to be successful during the transition to high school and help facilitate freshman success.

More and more studies show that if students have a positive experience their first year in high school, their chance for success increases dramatically. The Link Crew high school transition program provides the structure for freshmen to receive support and guidance from juniors and seniors who have been through the challenges that high school poses, and understand that the transition to a larger school can sometimes be overwhelming.

Link Crew begins with a powerful orientation day that makes freshmen excited and proud to be attending their new high school and allows them to begin developing relationships and strategies that will contribute to their high school success.

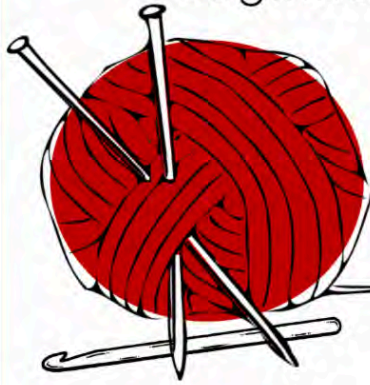

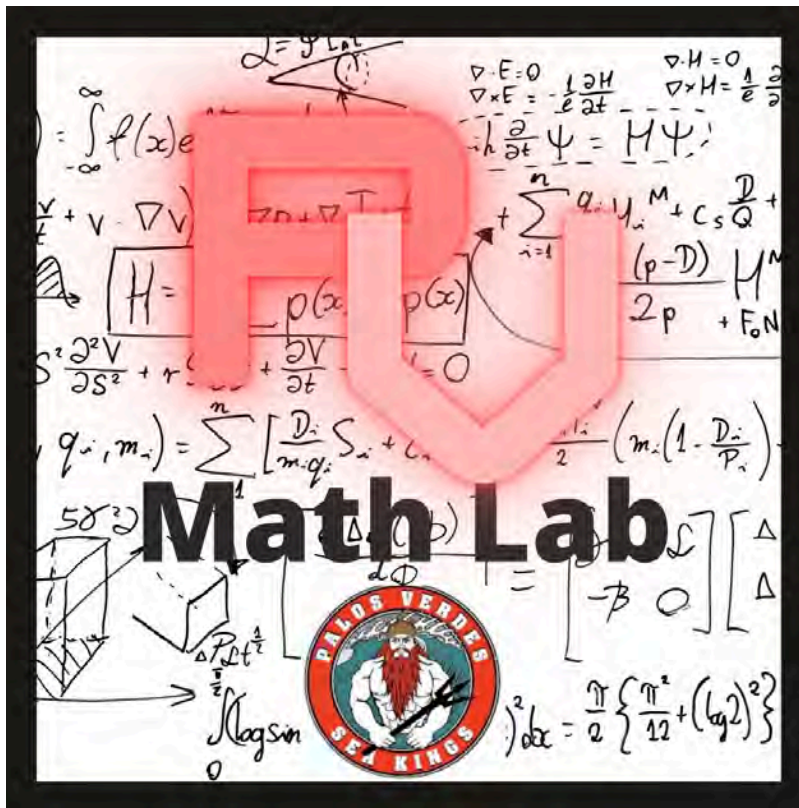

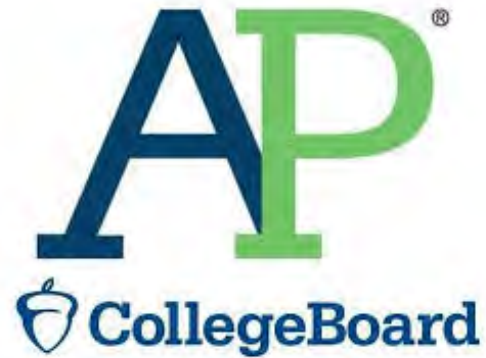

A school's scores on these tests are one of the biggest factors in determining a school's ranking, which colleges look at when they are considering students for admission. Thus, strong performance on the CAST (Science) and CAASPP ELA and Math tests is pivotal to maintaining our California school ranking and giving our students the best chance to get into top colleges and universities.

You're Invited to West Point RACE Event!

Interested in West Point? Come Learn What It Takes to Lead. PVHS students are cordially invited to attend a West Point RACE Event hosted by a United States Military Academy Admissions Officer.

This event is open to students of all ages and grade levels, and families are strongly encouraged to attend to learn more about the opportunities available at the United States Military Academy at West Point. We will begin with an informational session about West Point, covering academics, leadership development, military training, athletics, and the unique opportunities available to cadets. Students and families will learn what makes West Point one of the nation's premier leadership institutions and how the admissions process works.

Students who already have an open West Point application will have the opportunity to ask specific questions about their application, receive guidance on next steps, and better understand how to strengthen their candidate file.

Following the information session, students with open applications will have the opportunity to attempt the Candidate Fitness Assessment (CFA). The CFA is the official physical fitness test required for admission to West Point and measures a candidate's strength, agility, speed, and endurance through six events:

- Basketball throw (upper body power)
- Pull-ups or flexed-arm hang
- Shuttle run (agility)
- Push-ups
- Sit-ups
- One-mile run

Students with open applications may choose to complete the CFA for record, meaning the results can be submitted as part of their official admissions file.

The event will begin in a classroom/auditorium setting for the information session and application discussion, and then we will move to a nearby fitness area for the CFA.

Whether you are just starting to explore West Point or already in the application process, this event is a great opportunity to learn more, ask questions, and challenge yourself.

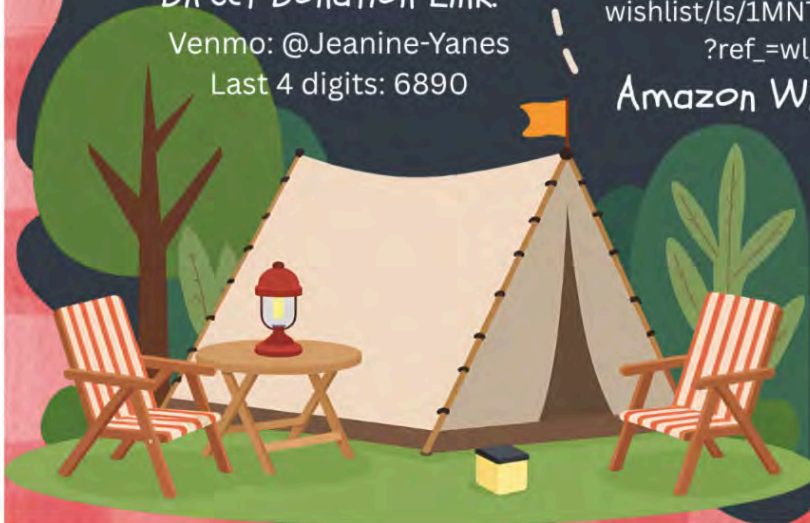

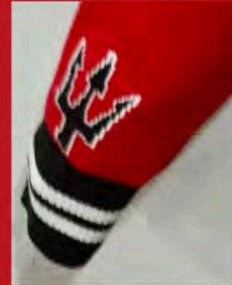

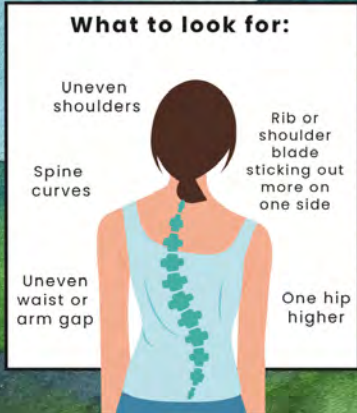

What is Scoliosis?

Scoliosis is a condition where the spine curves and twists to the side instead of growing in a straight line.

Why Teens Should Be Aware

- Research shows a MUCH higher percentage of dancers may have scoliosis compared to the general population
- Scoliosis is more common in girls than in boys
- Scoliosis can occur suddenly in kids ages 10-16 during a growth spurt. (sometimes younger)

Awareness helps teens stay informed.

Why Early Detection Matters

- More treatment options
 - Better monitoring during growth
 - Helps support injury prevention
- Many athletes can continue their sports fully and safely. **Early detection often means observation and guidance, not extreme treatment.**

Important to Know

- Scoliosis is not caused by bad posture or carrying heavy backpacks.
- Many cases are idiopathic. (no known cause)
- Having scoliosis does not always mean that you must stop your sport

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SCOLIOSIS IN CHILDREN & TEENS

Nearly 3% of the U.S. population has been diagnosed with scoliosis. When treated correctly, children can lead **healthy, active, fulfilling lives.**

WHAT IS SCOLIOSIS?

Scoliosis is a medical condition defined by a sideways curve of the spine, typically forming a "C" or "S" shape. It can be hereditary and appear in infancy, or develop during puberty as growth spurts occur.

SIGNS & SYMPTOMS

Each child may have a unique combination of these symptoms. Look for:

- ✓ One shoulder blade sticks out noticeably more than the other
- ✓ Ribs protrude more prominently on one side
- ✓ Tilted or uneven shoulders — may make clothing appear crooked
- ✓ Uneven waistline or hip bones, which can make pants legs appear uneven
- ✓ Head does not appear centered with the rest of the body



QUESTIONS EVERY PARENT ASKS

- Q: Will my child need surgery?**
Most don't—over 75% never need surgery. Many cases are managed with monitoring or bracing alone.
- Q: Do braces really work?**
Yes—bracing stops progression in 80%+ of kids. Our custom braces allow comfortable, flexible movement.
- Q: Can my child still play sports?**
Yes. Almost all sports are encouraged. Physical activity is healthy and generally not restricted.
- Q: How long do they wear a brace?**
Usually 12–24 months, and often only at night depending on severity and growth stage.

It often does during growth—but early care like monitoring and bracing keeps most curves mild and manageable.

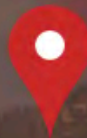
