WHAT FAMILIES NEED TO KNOW

Expect some delays September 21–25, 2026

Crews will remove and repave sections of Palos Verdes Drive West between Apsley Road and 621 PVDW. Please allow extra travel time — especially around school drop-off and pickup.

Project overview

The City of Palos Verdes Estates is resurfacing Palos Verdes Drive West between Apsley Road and 621 PVDW. Crews remove worn sections of asphalt and lay a fresh overlay, giving the corridor a smoother, longer-lasting surface.

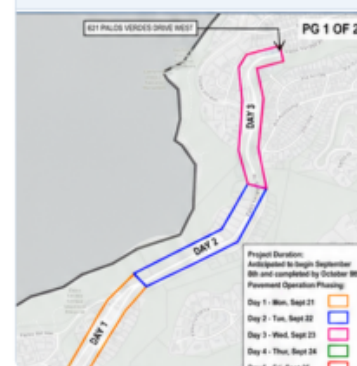

SCHOLARSHIP UPDATE:

The 2027 MVS application is now open.

The application deadline is November 12, 2026.

The Elks National Foundation (ENF) awards 500 four-year scholarships based on academics, leadership, and financial need. National awards range from \$1,000 per year to \$7,500 per year. The national awards will be announced in April 2027. **MVS scholarship applicants will also be eligible to receive a scholarship from our Lodge, District, and/or State.**

MVS scholarships are for high school seniors who plan to pursue a four-year degree on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 semester hours), at a U.S. college or university starting 2027-28.

Some important applicant details include:

- « Current high school seniors (or equivalent) who are citizens of the United States are eligible to apply.
- « Applicants do not have to be related to a member of the Elks.
- « Male and female students compete separately.

Applicants select from a list of the Lodges closest to their home address zip code.

REQUIREMENTS FOR CATEGORIES A, B, & C



Valid Form of Identification

- Driver's License
- Identification Card
- Passport



Tuberculosis (TB) Risk Assessment

- To access the TB Risk Assessment Form, scan the QR code or visit tinyurl.com/VolunteerTBRisk
- If applicable: TB results must show date given, date read, results, and name of medical facility.
- Assessments and/or results are valid for four years.



Raptor Check-In

- When arriving at a school site, volunteers must present a valid state-issued identification to use with the Raptor system.
- Volunteers will receive a sticker with their name and volunteer location after checking in.

REQUIREMENTS FOR CATEGORIES B & C

• Live Scan Background Check

- To request a Live Scan Background Check, scan the QR code or visit tinyurl.com/PVPUSDBackgroundCheck



• California Annual Mandated Reporter Training

- Before volunteering, provide your training certificate to the school office.
- This training must be completed and updated annually.
- To complete the training, scan the QR code or visit mandatedreportertraining.com/volunteers-training
- If you are a first responder or educator, you may use that training certificate.
