During the presentation, PVHS counselors cover valuable information about community college options, the four-year college application process, how

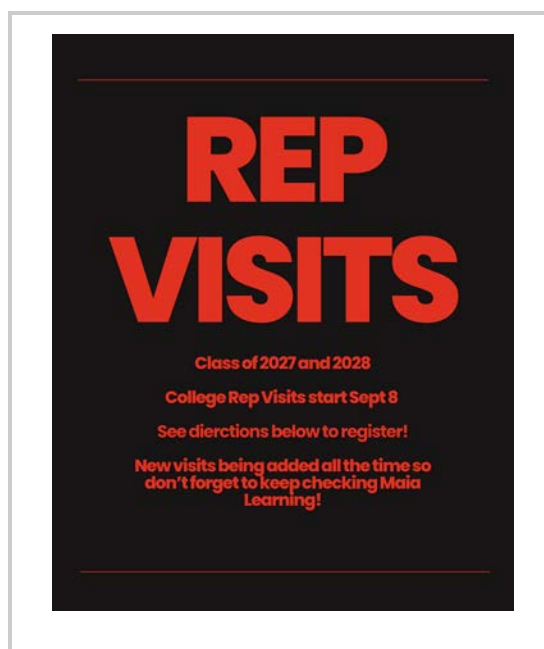
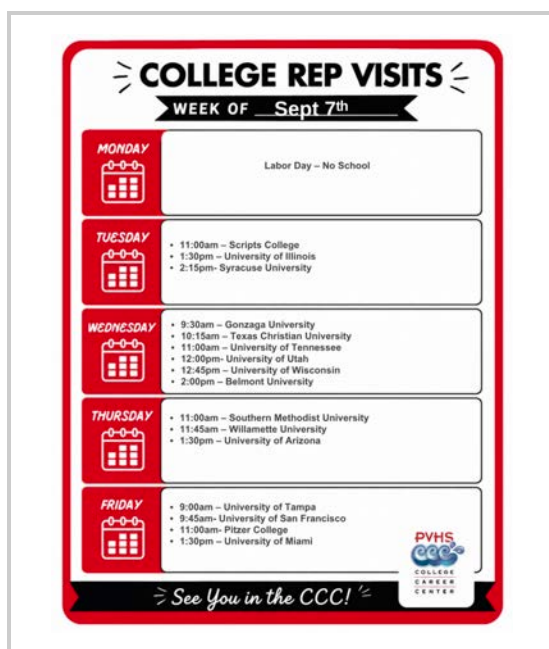
students can request letters of recommendation, and upcoming events in the College and Career Center. This is a great opportunity to stay informed and support your senior through this important year.

College Rep Visits are open to Seniors and Juniors and offer a 30 minute info session with visiting colleges. Rep Visits start on September 8th. HOW TO SIGN UP FOR VISITS

IMPORTANT - 2 STEP PROCESS



STEP 1

REGISTER IN MAIA LEARNING

- ✓ Log into your Maia Learning account
- ✓ Go to the Events Tab – select “Visits”
- ✓ Find the desired visit you want to attend
- ✓ Click “Attend” or “View” under the “Actions” column to sign up
- ✓ Get your teacher permission slip signed and put your visit in your calendar
- ✓ If you can't attend a visit, you must inform the CCC by canceling your visit on Maia Learning or telling Mrs. Nelson. Advance notice is needed if you book a space and no longer can use it.



STEP 2

TEACHER PERMISSION

- ✓ Teacher permission is necessary to attend a Rep Visit and miss class
- ✓ Pick up a Rep Visit Slip in the CCC and fill it out
- ✓ Take the slip to your teacher to ask them for permission to miss class to attend.
Please ask at least 24 hours in advance.
- ✓ Have your teacher sign the slip to give you permission
- ✓ Bring the slip with you – this is your ticket in the door for the visit.
- ✓ Once the visit is over, Mrs Nelson will sign your slip and you will bring it back to your teacher to validate that you were in the visit.

24 HOURS IN ADVANCE.

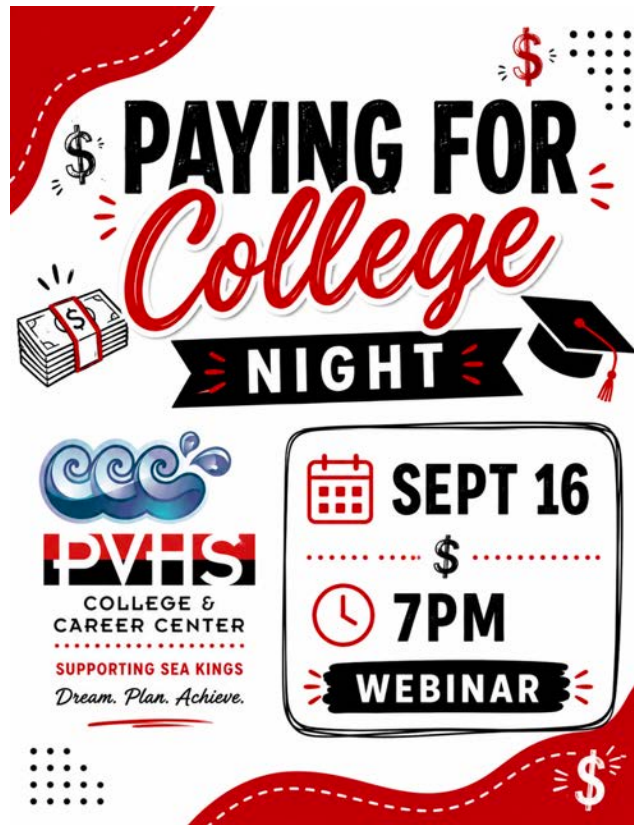

SCHOLARSHIP UPDATE:

The 2027 MVS application is now open.

The application deadline is November 12, 2026.

The Elks National Foundation (ENF) awards 500 four-year scholarships based on academics, leadership, and financial need. National awards range from \$1,000 per year to \$7,500 per year. The national awards will be announced in April 2027. **MVS scholarship applicants will also be eligible to receive a scholarship from our Lodge, District, and/or State.**

MVS scholarships are for high school seniors who plan to pursue a four-year degree on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 semester hours), at a U.S. college or university starting 2027-28.

Some important applicant details include:

- « Current high school seniors (or equivalent) who are citizens of the United States are eligible to apply.
- « Applicants do not have to be related to a member of the Elks.
- « Male and female students compete separately.

Applicants select from a list of the Lodges closest to their home address zip code.

REQUIREMENTS FOR CATEGORIES A, B, & C



Valid Form of Identification

- Driver's License
- Identification Card
- Passport



Tuberculosis (TB) Risk Assessment

- To access the TB Risk Assessment Form, scan the QR code or visit tinyurl.com/VolunteerTBRisk
- If applicable: TB results must show date given, date read, results, and name of medical facility.
- Assessments and/or results are valid for four years.



Raptor Check-In

- When arriving at a school site, volunteers must present a valid state-issued identification to use with the Raptor system.
- Volunteers will receive a sticker with their name and volunteer location after checking in.

REQUIREMENTS FOR CATEGORIES B & C

- Live Scan Background Check
 - To request a Live Scan Background Check, scan the QR code or visit tinyurl.com/PVPUSDBackgroundCheck



- California Annual Mandated Reporter Training
 - Before volunteering, provide your training certificate to the school office.
 - This training must be completed and updated annually.
 - To complete the training, scan the QR code or visit mandatedreportertraining.com/volunteers-training.
 - If you are a first responder or educator, you may use that training certificate.
